- **Equity, Diversity & Inclusion** – Strategies for engaging underrepresented groups, gender diversity, and accessibility in STEM.
- **Industry & Workforce Development** – Collaboration between academia and industry, STEM skills for the future workforce.
- **Interdisciplinary STEM Education** – Integrating arts (STEAM), humanities, and social sciences with STEM disciplines.
- **Assessment & Evaluation** – Measuring learning outcomes, innovative assessment techniques, and educational research methods.

- **STEM Policy & Curriculum Development** – National and international trends, curriculum frameworks, and policy implications.
- **Early Childhood & K-12 STEM Education** – Best practices for engaging young learners in STEM subjects.
- **Higher Education & Research in STEM** – University-level STEM teaching, research experiences, and postgraduate education.
- **Community & Informal STEM Learning** – Museums, science festivals, outreach programs, and citizen science initiatives.
